






# RESILIENCE IN TRANSPORTATION PLANNING

- Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST ACT) 2015
  - Improve transportation system resiliency and reliability.
  - Reducing (or mitigating) the stormwater impacts of surface transportation.
  - CTDOT 2018 Statewide Long-Range Transportation Plan
    - Improve reliability of the transportation system by addressing vulnerabilities.
    - Integrate 'green' transportation practices into all Department activities from planning to design and construction to operations.

### RESILIENCE IN TRANSPORTATION PLANNING

#### **GBVMPO 2019 Metropolitan Transportation Plan: Resiliency Projects**


- Raise Roads for Resiliency: Fairfield's Post Road/US 1 flooding potentially effects 20,000 vehicles per day
- Green Infrastructure Projects
  - Installation of bioretention, bioswales, rain gardens and tree box plantings.
  - Daylight watercourses to improve inland drainage and reduce downstream roadway flooding.

#### REGIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLANNING

- FEMA requirement for municipalities to access federal disaster assistance, mitigation grant funding and program eligibility.
- All CT COGS have FEMA approved regional plans
  - Identify and analyze hazards locally and regionally
  - Enable regional project prioritization



# FEMA COMMUNITY RATING SYSTEM (CRS)

- Reduces residential flood insurance premiums for accepted municipalities.
- MetroCOG CRS Communities
  - Fairfield, Stratford and Trumbull all accepted between 2018 and 2019 (Class 8 rating).
  - Bridgeport currently in the application process.
- MetroCOG Application Assistance
  - Developed and maintained flood hazard websites.
  - Hosted required FEMA GIS Layers in municipal parcel viewers.
  - Added additional flood hazard information to each municipal parcel.
  - Assisted with map creation and spatial analysis.

#### RESILIENT CONNECTICUT

- Significant local and regional planning over the last 5 to 10 years to analyze and identify
- Create and utilize a framework for hazard reduction and economic impact analysis to prioritize projects
- Create conceptual/preliminary designs for highest priority projects
