

<p>A portion of eastern Wethersfield overlaps with flood zones associated with the Connecticut River. The Public Works building within this area has reportedly flooded on multiple occasions, and the town has previously expressed interest in relocating this facility. In addition, Beaver Brook flows parallel to Rt 99, where municipal, educational, and commercial facilities are located. Rt 99 reportedly overtops during 100-year storms near Mill and Maple Streets. The wider area is characterized by moderate to high flood and heat vulnerability, as well as moderate social vulnerability.</p>



<p>Una parte del este de Wethersfield se superpone con zonas de inundación asociadas con el río Connecticut. Según los informes, el edificio de Obras Públicas dentro de esta área se ha inundado en múltiples ocasiones, y la ciudad ha expresado previamente su interés en reubicar esta instalación. Además, Beaver Brook fluye paralelo a la Ruta 99, donde se encuentran las instalaciones municipales, educativas y comerciales. Según los informes, la ruta 99 se desborda durante tormentas de 100 años cerca de las calles Mill y Maple. El área más amplia se caracteriza por una vulnerabilidad moderada a alta a las inundaciones y el calor, así como una vulnerabilidad social moderada.</p>
