

The Greeneville Norwich neighborhood along the Shetucket River is home to the Greeneville Historic District as well as multiple critical facilities. The area is characterized by high flood and heat vulnerability, as well as high social vulnerability. The Norwich Public Utilities facility on South Golden Street is also the EOC for the City of Norwich. There is potential interest among City staff in creating more green space and recreational opportunities within this area. Additional green space could assist with heat mitigation and increased stormwater retention.


