

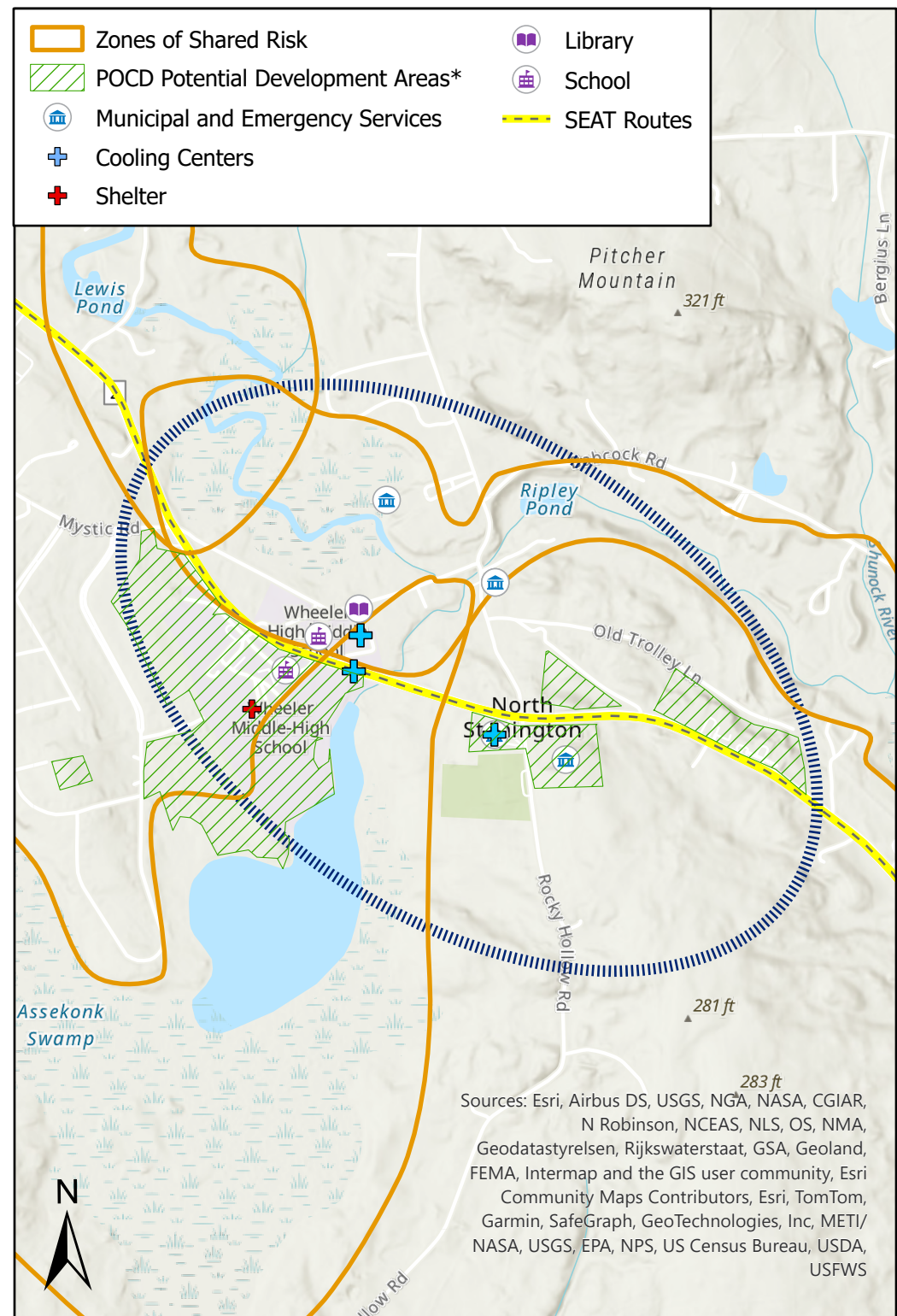

| <p>Multiple North Stonington critical facilities and community assets, including educational services, are clustered in the vicinity of the Shunock River and its offshoots, as well as Rt 2. The area is characterized by moderate flood vulnerability, heat vulnerability, and social vulnerability. The town does not have an overnight shelter, so in the case of an extreme event requiring overnight shelter use, residents would need to travel to a regional shelter in Stonington or Norwich.</p> | | | | | |

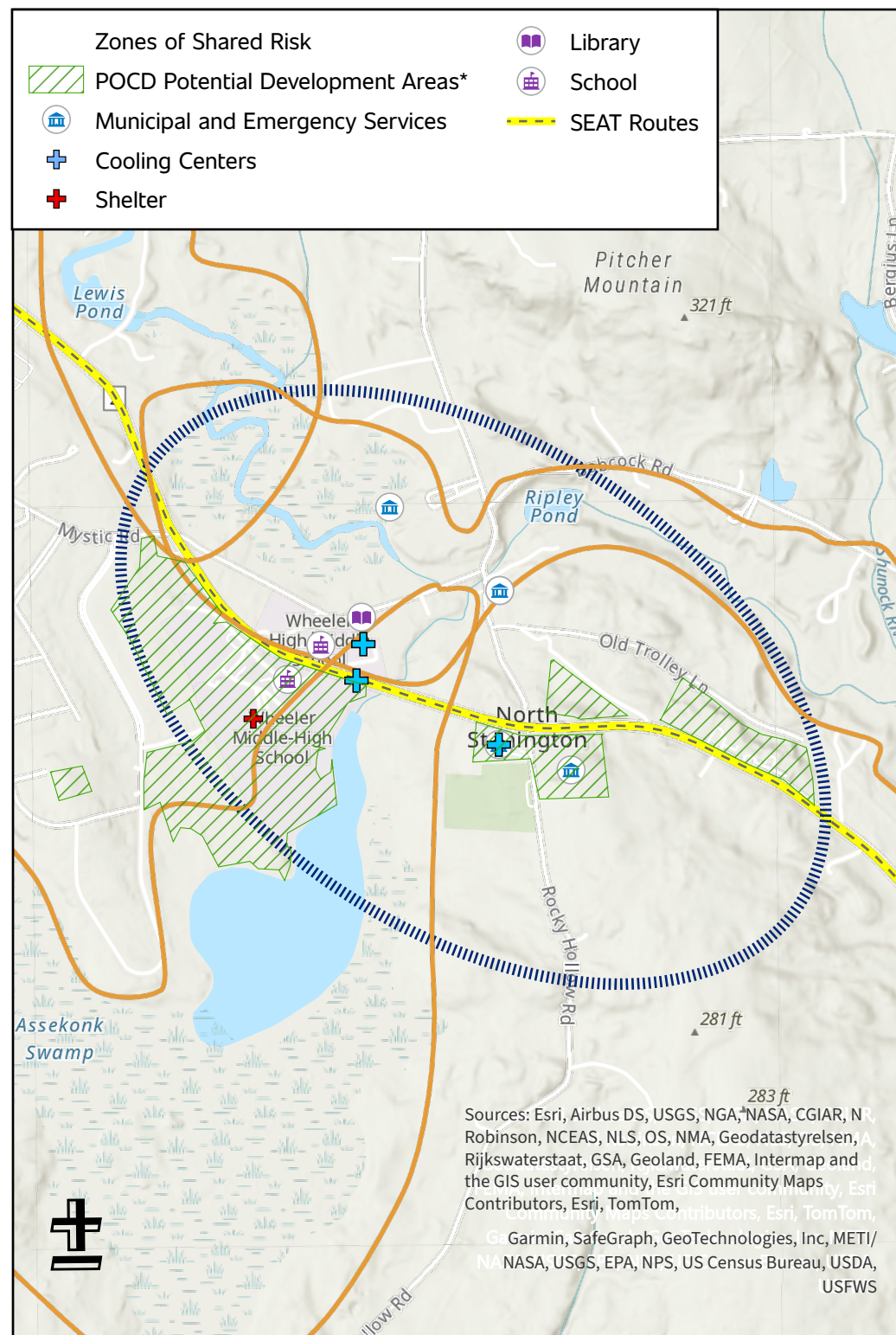

Múltiples instalaciones críticas y activos comunitarios de North Stonington, incluidos los servicios educativos, se agrupan en las cercanías del río Shunock y sus ramificaciones, así como en la Ruta 2. El área se caracteriza por una vulnerabilidad moderada a las inundaciones, al calor y a la vulnerabilidad social. La ciudad no tiene un refugio para pasar la noche, por lo que en el caso de un evento extremo que requiera el uso de un refugio durante la noche, los residentes tendrían que viajar a un refugio regional en Stonington o Norwich.
