



| Trout Brook runs from north to south through West Hartford and intersects with the South Branch of the Park River near the Hartford line. The wider area is characterized by high flood vulnerability, heat vulnerability, and social vulnerability. West Hartford and Hartford have received a DEEP Climate Resilience Fund grant to pursue engineering studies and preliminary designs for reducing flooding in the areas of Kane Brook and Kennedy Brook, which are within this ROAR. This area also includes many schools as well as TOD potential due to multiple transit stations for the Hartford Line and Fastrak Guideway. | | | | | |

| Trout Brook corre de norte a sur a través de West Hartford y se cruza con la rama sur del río Park cerca de la línea de Hartford. El área más amplia se caracteriza por una alta vulnerabilidad a las inundaciones, al calor y a la vulnerabilidad social. West Hartford y Hartford han recibido una subvención del Fondo de Resiliencia Climática DEEP para realizar estudios de ingeniería y diseños preliminares para reducir las inundaciones en las áreas de Kane Brook y Kennedy Brook, que se encuentran dentro de este ROAR. Esta área también incluye muchas escuelas, así como el potencial de TOD debido a las múltiples estaciones de tránsito para la línea Hartford y Fastrak Guideway. | | | | | |
