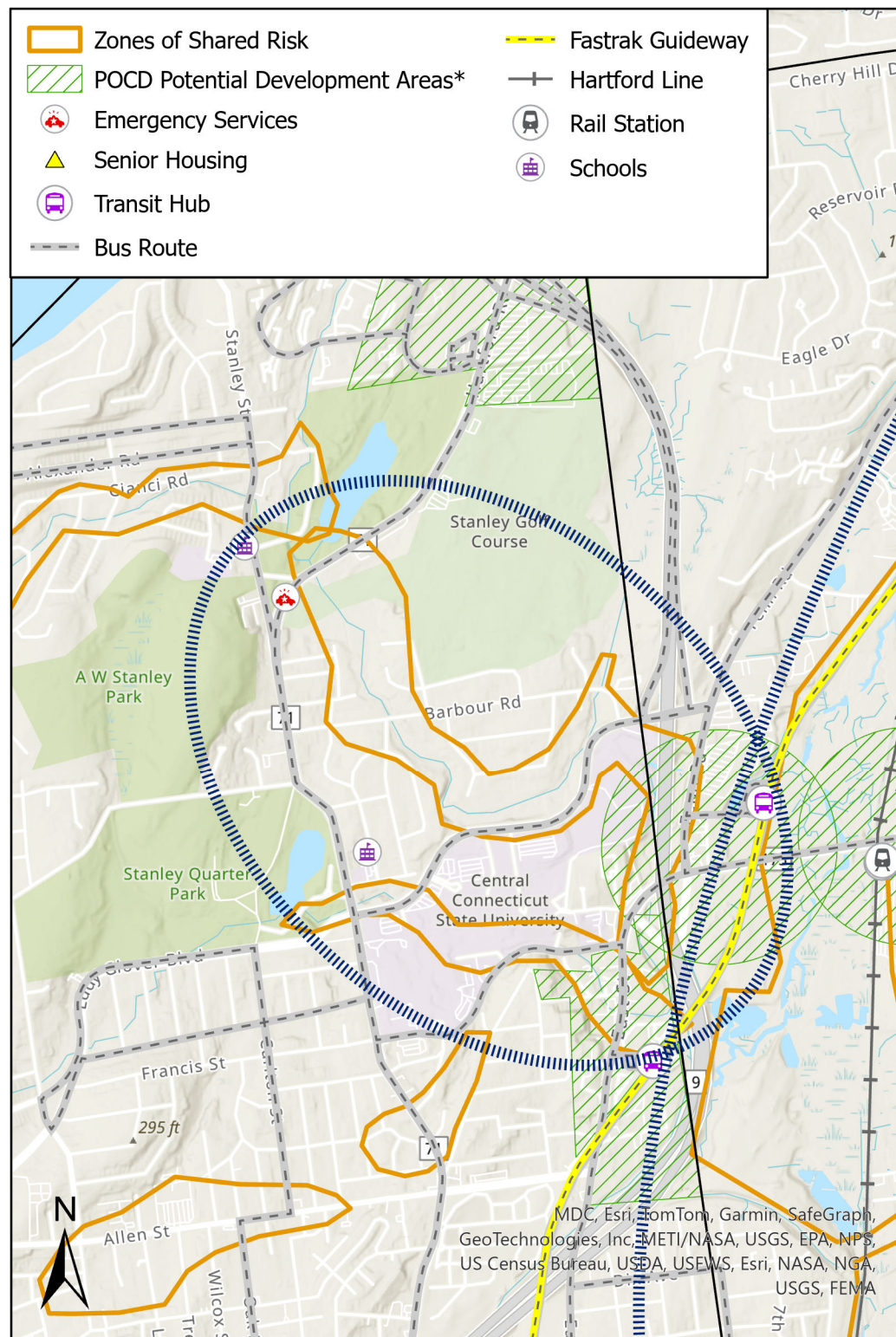

The campus of Central Connecticut State University is located in the northeast corner of New Britain. Multiple 1% annual chance flood zones are in close proximity to the university campus, including those associated with Bass Brook. There are stream crossings intersecting multiple roads in the vicinity, raising potential access issues if these roads are impacted by flooding; the residential neighborhood to the north of the university may also be vulnerable to this concern. Alongside high flood vulnerability, the area is also characterized by moderate heat and social vulnerability.
