The western portion of the Town of South Windsor is characterized by moderate to high flood, heat, and social vulnerability. The 1% annual chance flood zone associated with the Connecticut River overlaps with multiple roads as well as the Town's Water Pollution Control Facility. In addition to the flood vulnerability associated with the Connecticut River, this ROAR also contains Newberry Brook, which is also in close proximity to the Water Pollution Control Facility.
