The Farmington River meets the Connecticut River in Windsor, with the associated 1% annual chance flood zones overlapping with multiple roadways in the area and potentially presenting access challenges in the case of flooding, including for the Loomis Chaffee School, which is surrounded by flood zones. Additional flood vulnerability is contributed by Mill Brook and tributaries between Washington Park and the Farmington River. In addition to high flood vulnerability, the broader area is characterized by moderate heat and social vulnerability.
