Cherry Brook intersects with Barbour Brook in the center of Canton, with multiple associated flood zones and multiple points where these brooks cross roadways. The Cherry Brook Primary School is located at this stream intersection, with the school property overlapping with the 1% annual chance flood zone. There is the potential for access and egress challenges for the school if these roadways are obstructed by flooding. The primary vulnerability for this ROAR is flood-related, with relatively low heat and social vulnerability.
