

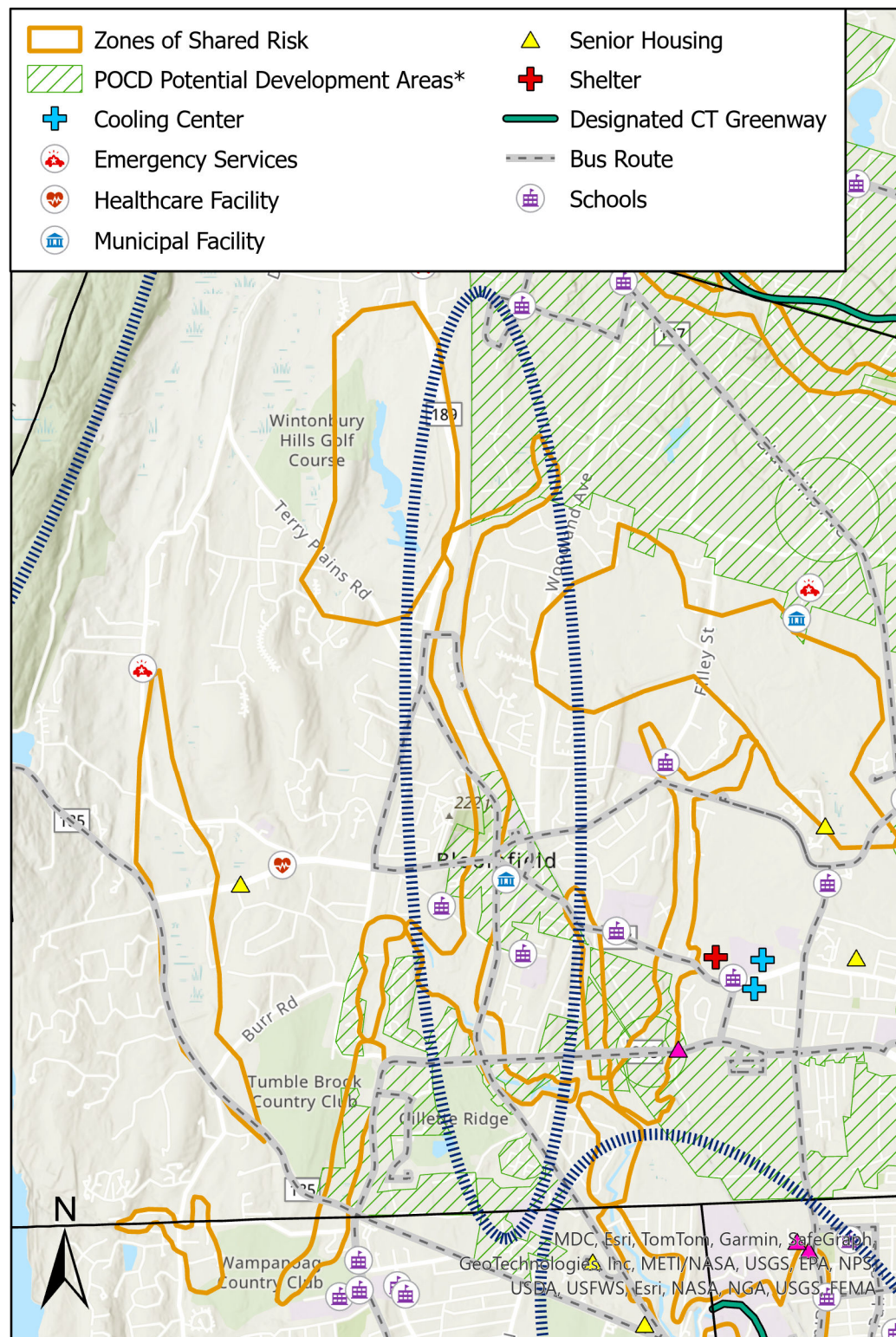

Wash Brook and its tributaries cross roadways at multiple points, including the routes of the Blue Hills Avenue Bus and the Bloomfield Avenue Bus. Critical facilities present in this ROAR include the Bloomfield Town Hall and the J.P. Vincent School, in a downtown that includes multiple restaurants and businesses as well.</p>
