

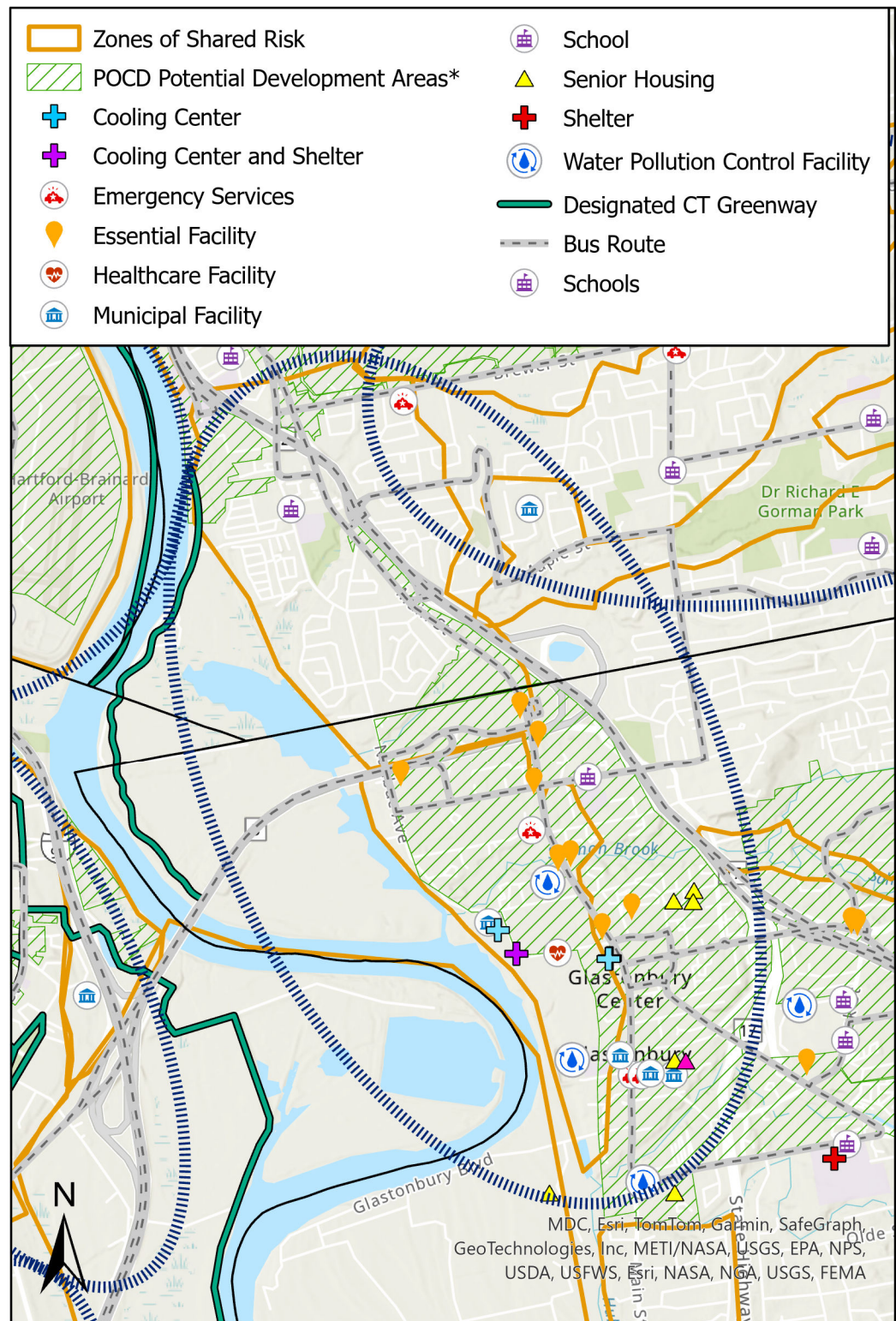

The broader area is characterized by high flood, heat, and social vulnerability. Additional flood vulnerability in this ROAR is associated with Pewterpot Brook, Porter Brook, and Salmon Brook.</p>
