

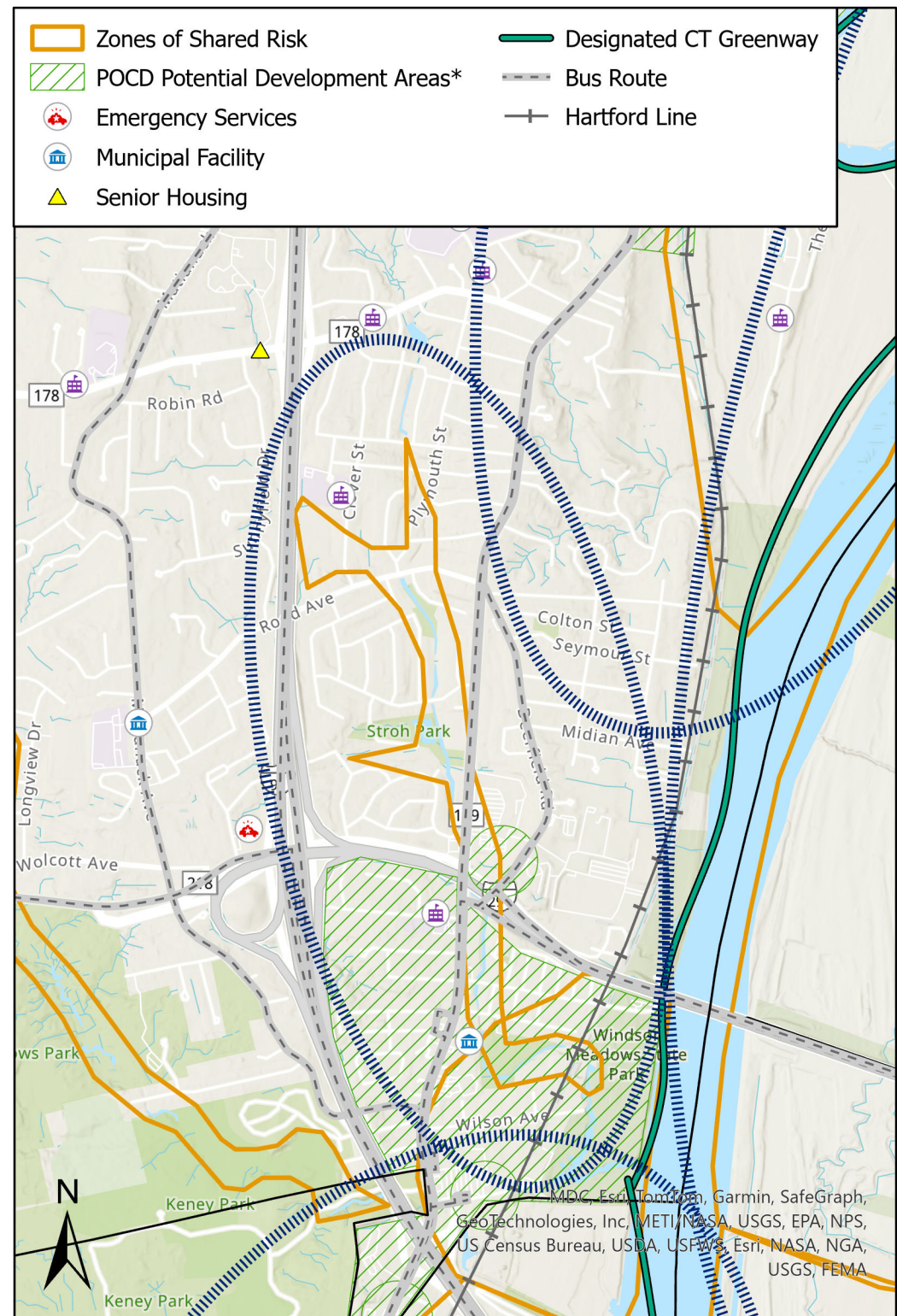

<p>Deckers Brook flows through the southeast corner of Windsor on its way to the Connecticut River. The 1% annual chance flood zones associated with this brook cross multiple roadways, presenting possible access concerns in the event of road flooding. In addition to this flood vulnerability, the broader area is characterized by high heat and social vulnerability. The community center located within this ROAR, which is located along Deckers Brook although not directly in the associated flood zone, has been identified previously in the Town's Hazard Mitigation Plan as a site for potential consideration for a future shelter.</p>
