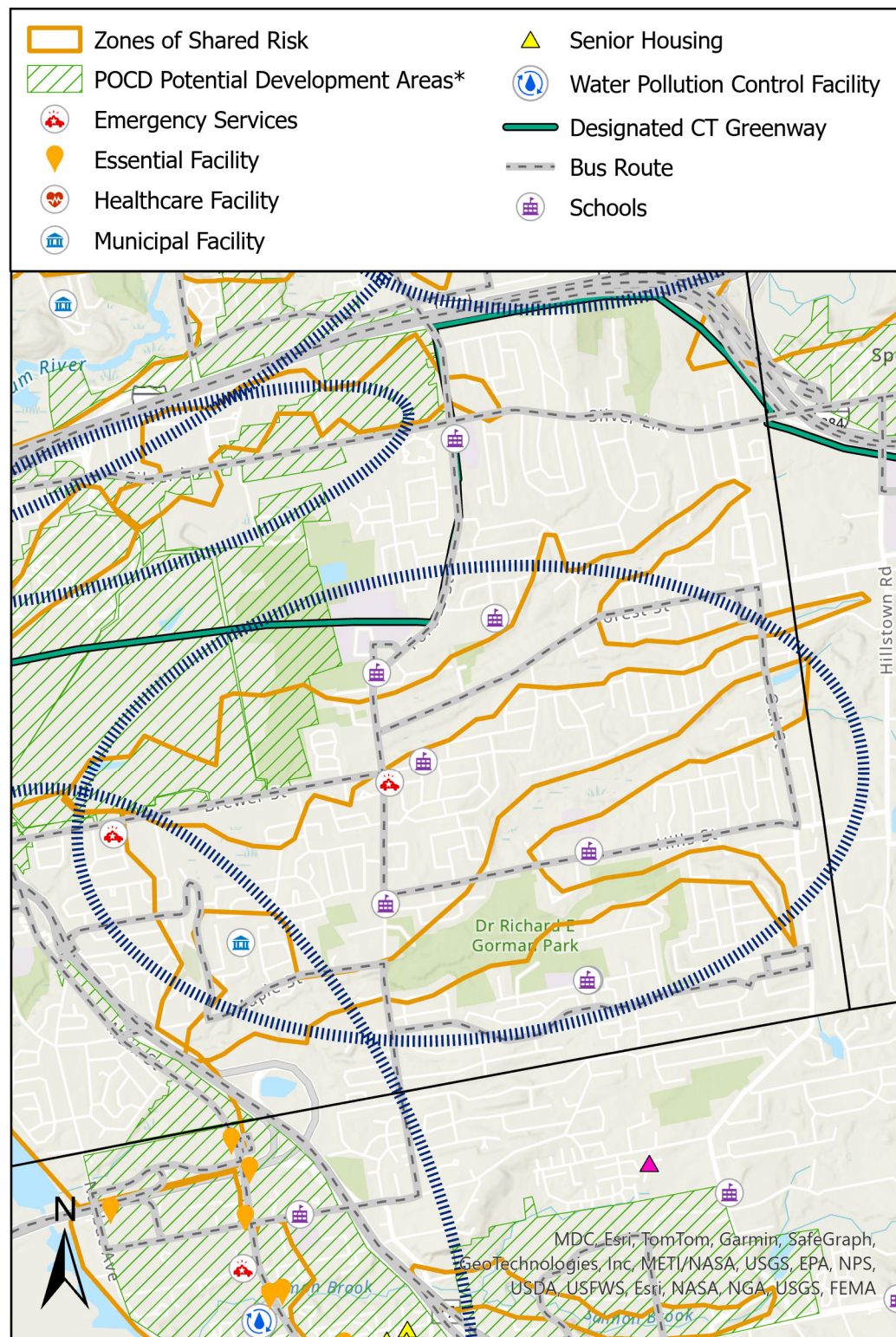

The Forest Village section of East Hartford is characterized by high flood, heat, and social vulnerability. Zones of Shared Risk in this area correspond to flood risks associated with Porter Brook, the Hill Ponds Branch of Porter Brook, and the North and South Branches of Pewterpot Brook. Critical facilities include multiple municipal facilities and many schools, some of which draw students from the wider region.
