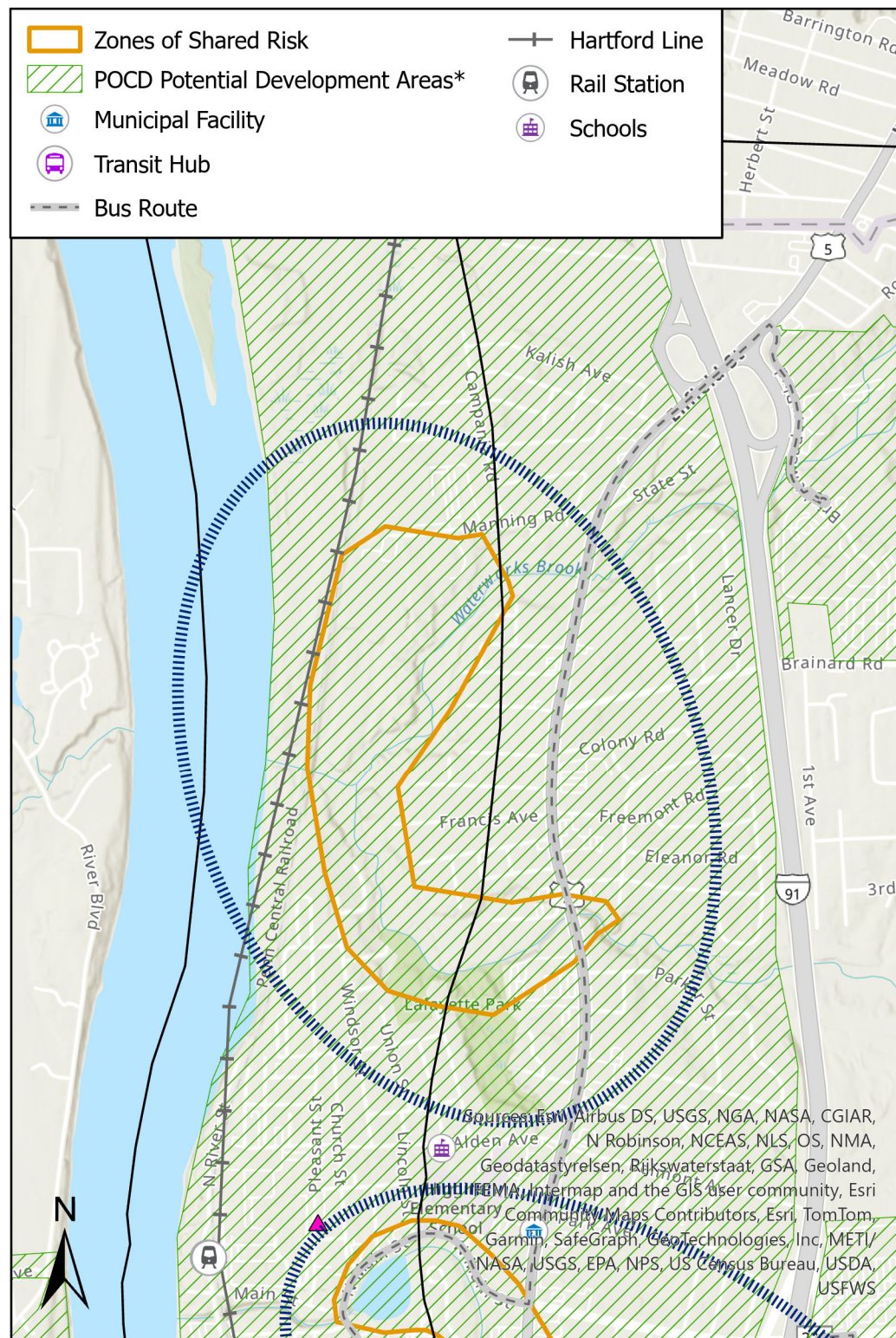

This ROAR captures the intersection of Grape Brook and Waterworks Brook. Both of these brooks also cross Route 5, leading to a possible isolation concern for the residential streets off Route 5 if these brooks flood. The larger area is characterized by high flood and heat vulnerability, as well as moderate social vulnerability. This area is just north of the Thompsonville section of Enfield, and may be a site of future transit-oriented development associated with the planned future Enfield Train Station.
