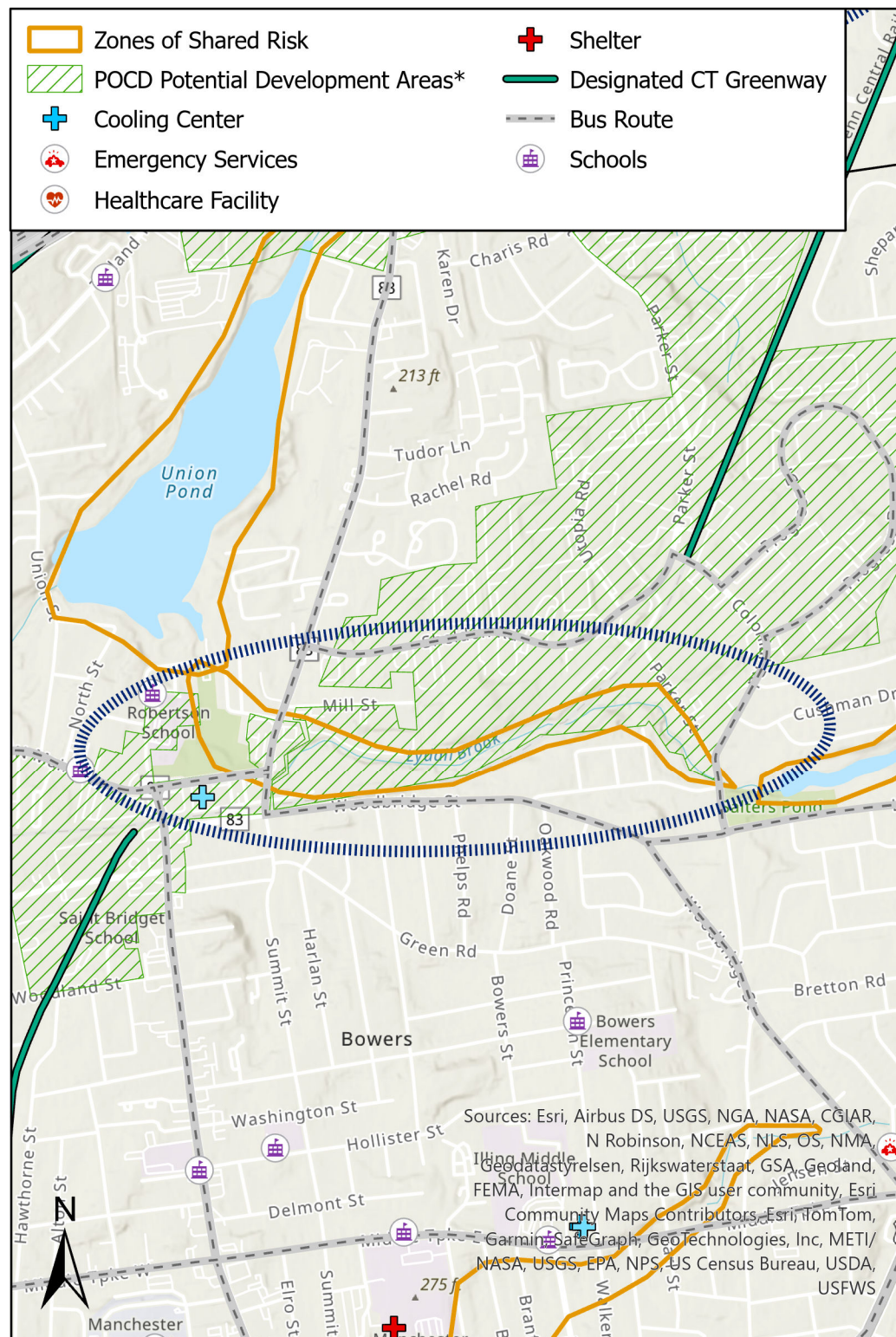

This ROAR captures the section of the Lydall Brook corridor between Salters Pond and Rt 83. This area is characterized by moderate to high flood, heat, and social vulnerability. Stream crossings include the intersection of Lydall Brook with Parker Street, as well as the point where the brook crosses the railroad tracks. The Whiton Branch Library has the capacity to act as a cooling center, although not a shelter.
