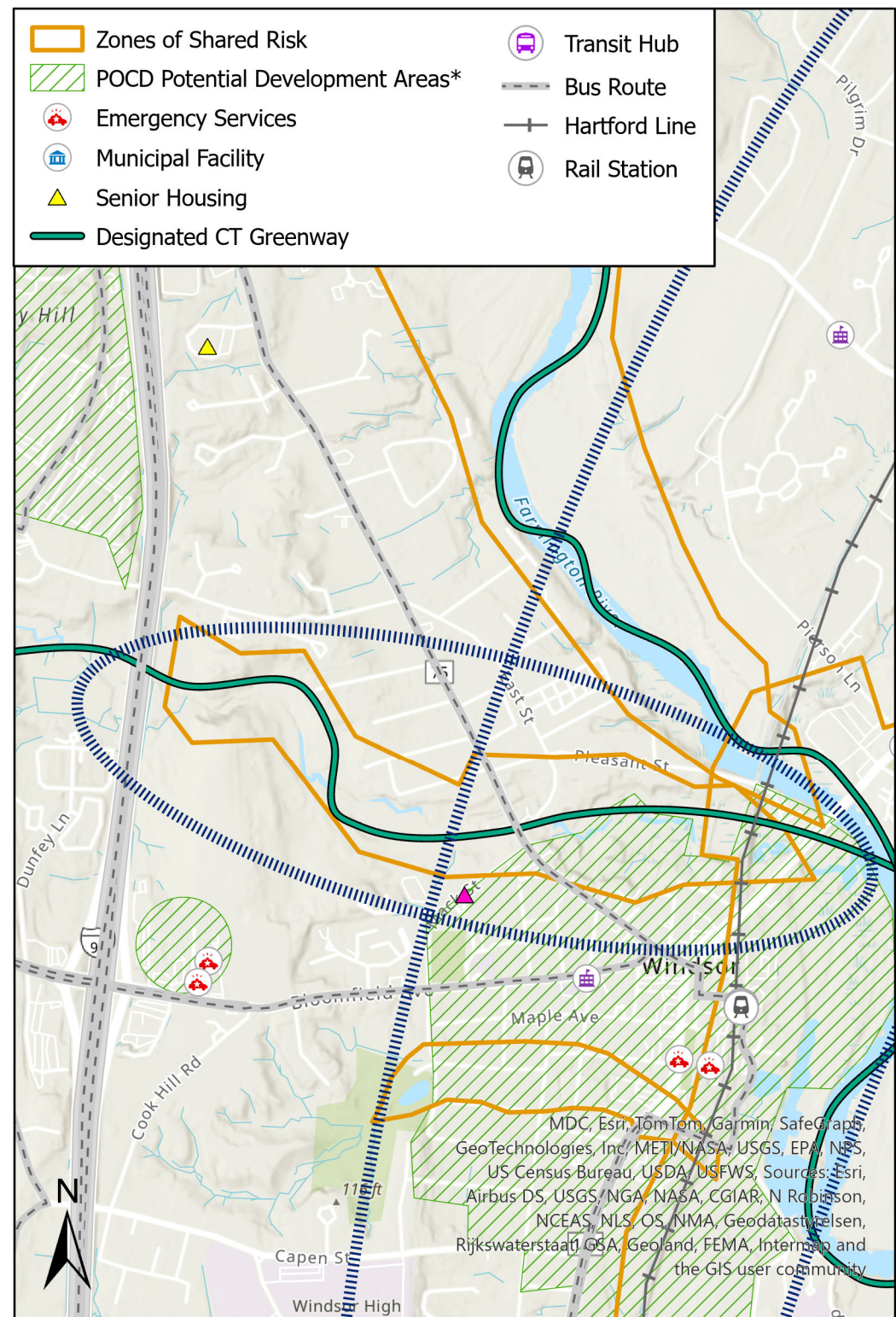

Mill Brook is a tributary of the Farmington River that crosses the Town of Windsor from west to east. On its way, it crosses multiple significant roadways, including I-91 and Rt 75. There are also potential TOD areas within this ROAR due to the proximity to the rail line. The broader area is characterized by moderate to high flood, heat, and social vulnerability.
