

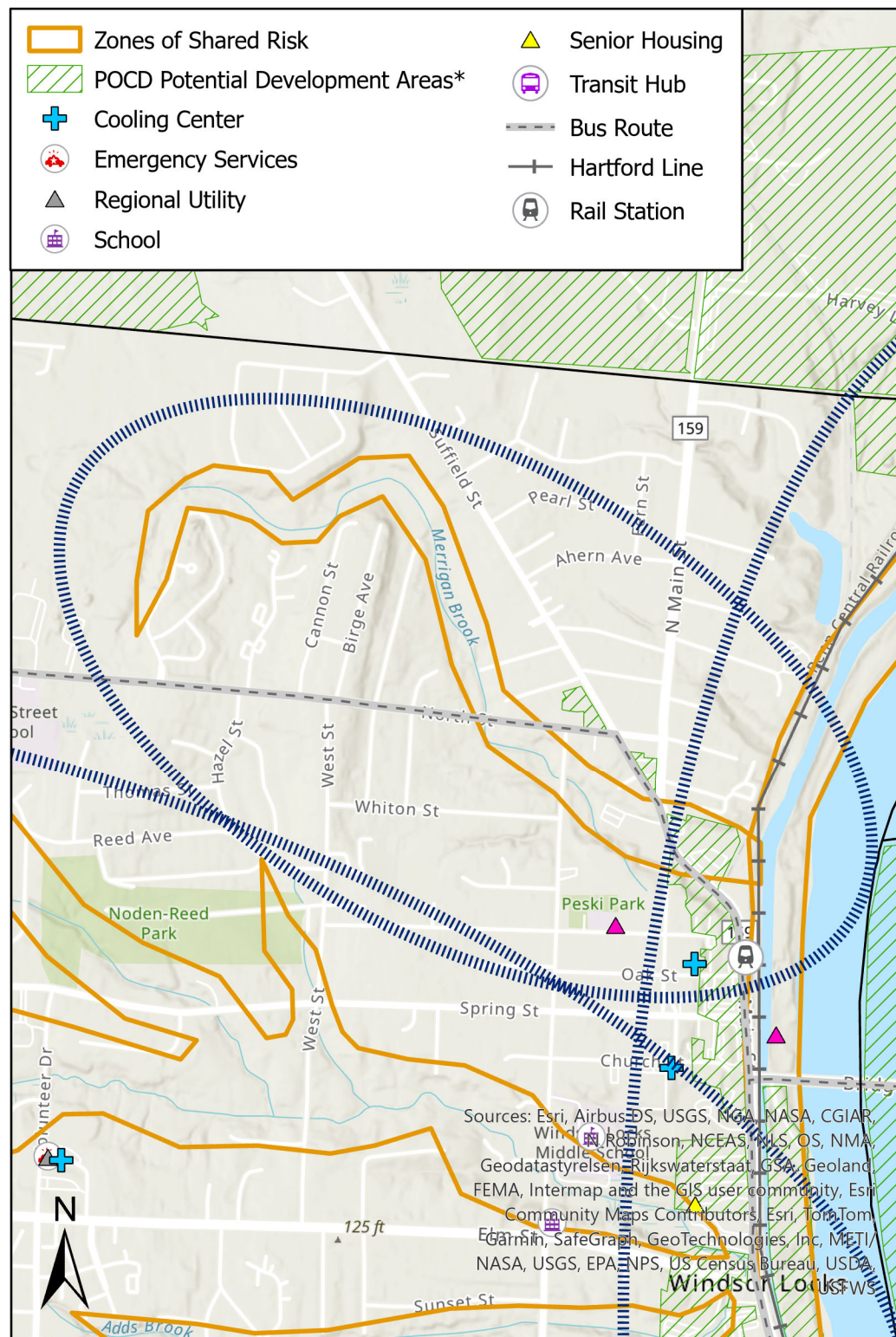

<p>Merrigan Brook flows through South Windsor near the intersection of North Street and Suffield Street towards the Connecticut River. There are multiple assets here that are significant to the town, including a new train station under construction, associated transit-oriented development potential, and a tax increment financing (TIF) district along the Connecticut River. The broader area is characterized by moderate to high flood, heat, and social vulnerability. The senior center has the potential to serve as a cooling center.</p>
