The Quinnipiac River intersects with the Tenmile River in the Milldale section of Southington, and the associated 1% annual chance flood zones cross multiple roadways in the area. The town's Water Pollution Control Facility as well as the South End School are both located within this ROAR; additional flood vulnerability near the school is associated with Misery Brook. The broader area is characterized by moderate to high flood and heat vulnerability, as well as high social vulnerability.
