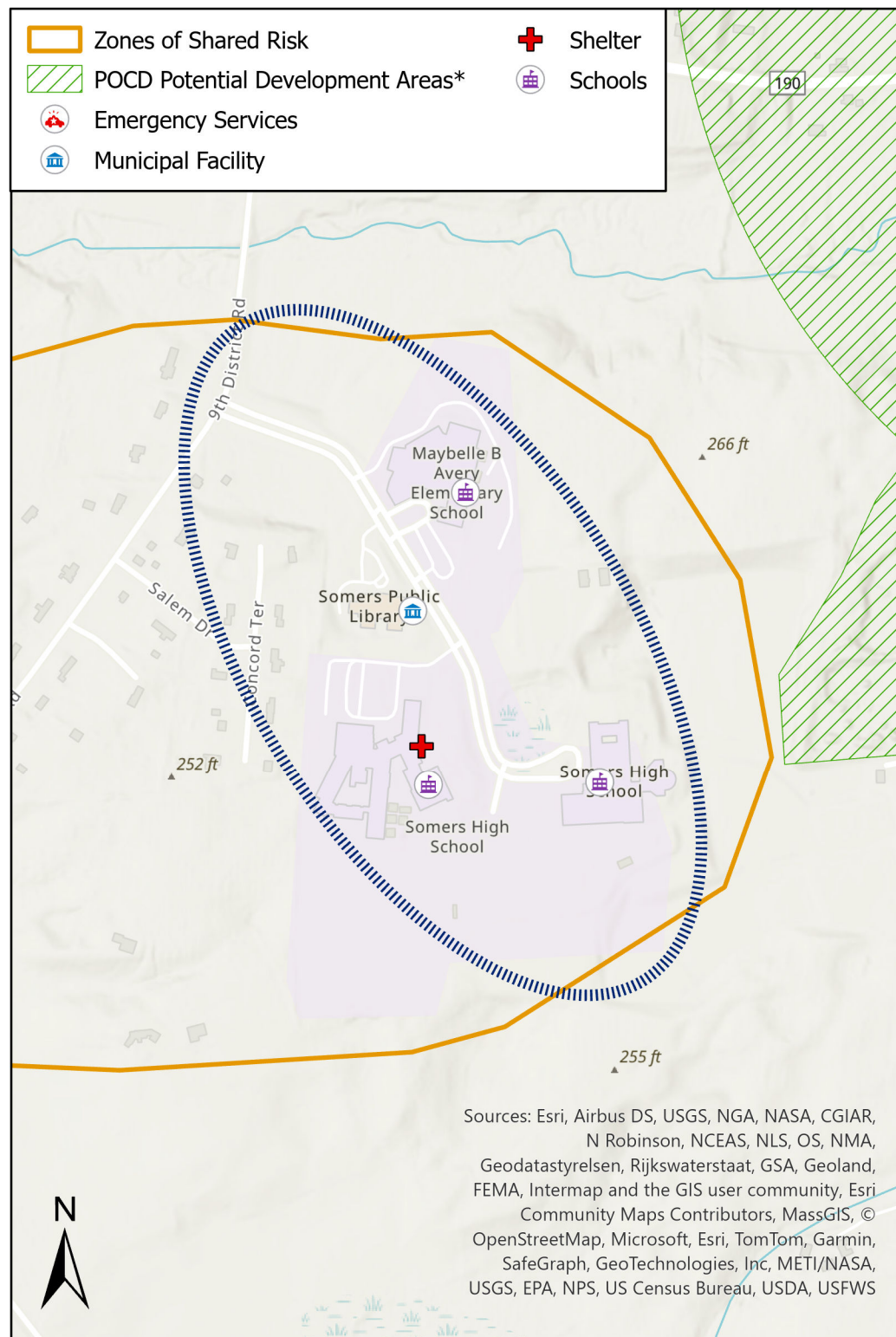

Unlike some of the larger ROARs identified through the Resilient Connecticut program, this site was selected because of individual site vulnerability. In this case, a cluster of schools serving the Town of Somers, as well as the Somers Public Library, are located in close proximity to the 1% annual chance flood zone associated with Gulf Stream. Gulf Stream crosses 9th District Road, which may present access issues in the event of road flooding. The wider area is characterized by moderate heat and social vulnerability. Somers High School can also serve as a shelter.
