



Downtown Hartford is characterized by very high flood vulnerability, heat vulnerability, and social vulnerability. A high level of impervious surfaces contributes to both the flood and heat vulnerability, with additional contributing factors including proximity to the Connecticut River and a lack of tree canopy. Socioeconomic factors contribute to a lack of adaptive capacity here, and multiple schools and affordable housing units within this ROAR add to the potential social vulnerability.

El Centro de Hartford se caracteriza por muy alta vulnerabilidad a las inundaciones, vulnerabilidad al calor, y vulnerabilidad social. Un alto nivel de superficies impermeables contribuyen tanto a la vulnerabilidad a las inundaciones como a la vulnerabilidad al calor, con factores adicionales contribuyentes, incluyendo la proximidad al río Connecticut y a la falta de dosel libre. Factores socioeconómicos contribuyen a la falta de capacidad adaptativa acá, y muchas escuelas y unidades de vivienda asequibles dentro de este ROAR añaden a la potencial vulnerabilidad social.
