

The primary campus of the University of Connecticut is located in Storrs in the Town of Mansfield. Eagleville Brook runs directly through the campus. In addition to critical facilities associated with the university, multiple housing complexes and community assets for the Town of Mansfield are located within this ROAR. The high school serves as a regional shelter, while the community center serves as a local shelter for residents. The general area is characterized by low to moderate flood, heat, and social vulnerability.
