

The Thompsonville section of Enfield is adjacent to the Connecticut River and bounded to the east by Interstate 91. Thompsonville is characterized by moderate to high flood, heat, and social vulnerability. In addition to the Connecticut River, there is some flood vulnerability associated with Freshwater Brook, which runs through Thompsonville. Multiple critical and community facilities are present in this ROAR, and there is likely to be future transit-oriented development associated with a planned Enfield train station.



En adición al río Connecticut, hay un poco de vulnerabilidad a las inundaciones asociado con Freshwater Brook, que corre a través de Thompsonville. Hay varias instalaciones críticas y comunitarias presentes en este ROAR, y es probable que en el futuro haya un desarrollo orientado al tránsito asociado con una estación de tren planificada en Enfield.</p>
