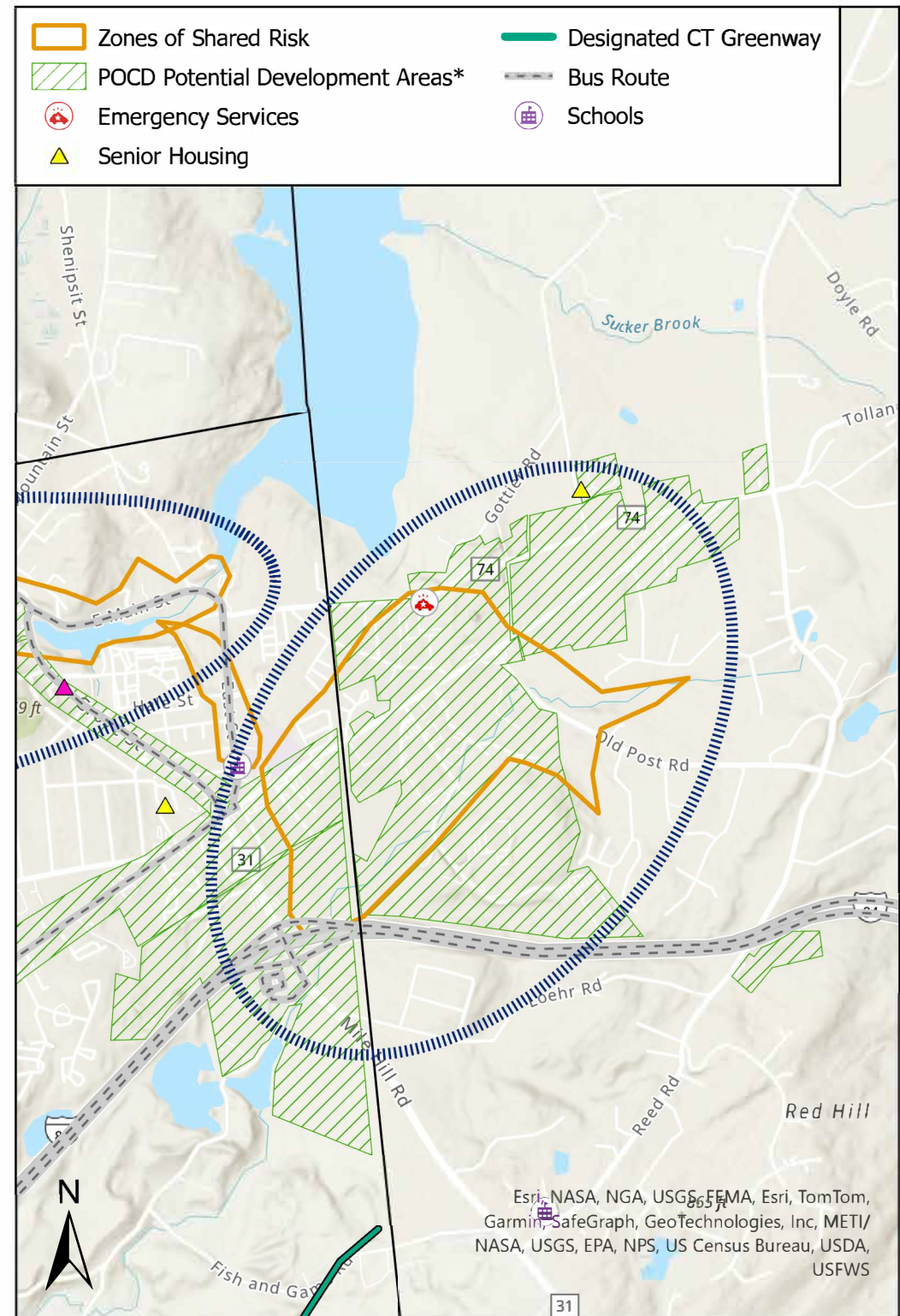

Quarryville is a section of the Town of Tolland located near the Vernon line below Shenipsit Lake. Gages Brook runs through Quarryville, crossing multiple roadways and posing a potential access concern if these roads are impacted by flooding. Town staff reported localized flooding from Gages Brook during the storms of 2021, including on Rt 30 and Kingsbury Avenue. The broader area is characterized by moderate flood and heat vulnerability, as well as relatively low social vulnerability. Town staff also reported that the water level in Shenipsit Lake dropped significantly during the 2022 drought.

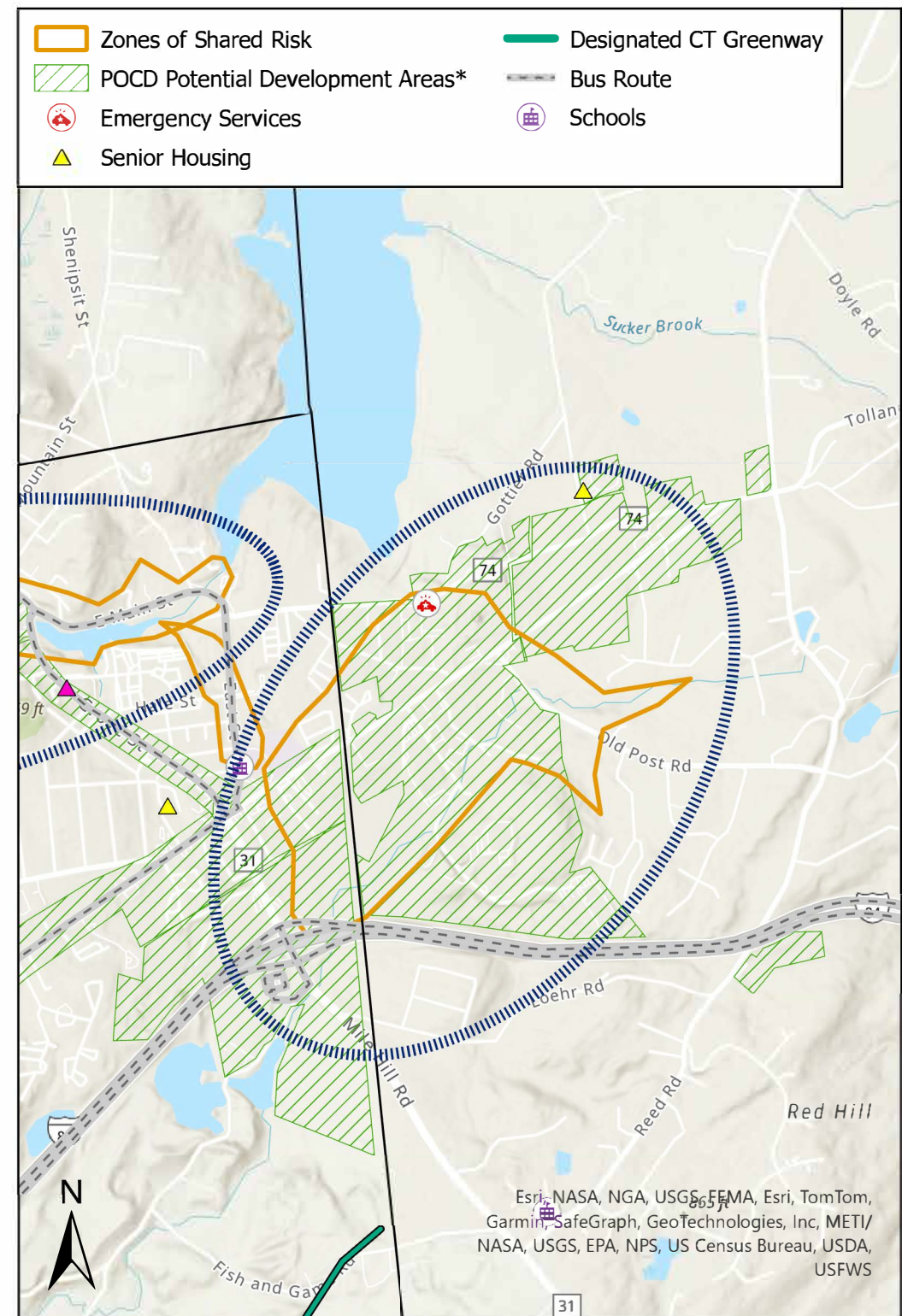

Quarryville es una sección del pueblo de Tolland ubicado cerca de la línea de Vernon abajo del lago Shenipsit. El arroyo Gages corre por Quarryville, cruzando múltiples carreteras y planteando un posible problema de acceso si estas calles son impactadas por inundaciones. El personal del pueblo reportó inundaciones localizadas del arroyo Gages durante las tormentas del 2021, incluyendo en la Ruta 30 y la Avenida Kingsbury. El área más amplia se caracteriza por moderada vulnerabilidad a las inundaciones y vulnerabilidad al calor, así como también relativamente baja vulnerabilidad social. El personal del pueblo también reportó que el nivel del agua en el lago Shenipsit bajó significativamente durante la sequiza del 2022.
